2017 Penfield Education Foundation Recipients

Albert E. Beguin – Albert Beguin was the founder of the Penfield Scholarship Association, now renamed Penfield Education. He designated this award to be given to a graduating senior interested in the medical profession.

2017 Recipient - Meredith Blackburn

Benjamin D. Schnauffer Art Scholarship – this award is selected by the Art Department and honors the PHS student, Benjamin Schnauffer, who took almost every art course that PHS offered. This award goes to a graduating senior who will be going on to study art in a college program.

Charlie Coté – this award is selected by the Music Department. The recipient must meet very specific, involved criteria, per the Music Departments and Coté family requirements.

Chhim, Him, and Sok Global Citizenship Scholarship – Socheth Sok was a 1998 graduate of Penfield High School. She arrived in the United States knowing very little English and worked incredibly hard to earn her diploma on time and go on to achieve her goals.
